

# CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Capital Line South LRT Utility Relocation Project  
111 Street Between 12 Avenue and 23 Avenue NW

**JUNE 2023**

## PROJECT OVERVIEW

As part of the Capital Line South LRT Extension Project, EPCOR is responsible for relocating all the power, water and drainage utilities to avoid potential conflicts with the future Capital Line South LRT extension infrastructure. This is an extension of the current Capital Line, which will operate from Century Park to Ellerslie Road. The Capital Line South LRT Relocation Project began in May 2023 and is expected to be completed by the end of the year.

## WHAT'S HAPPENING?

To meet the overall LRT project schedule, the City of Edmonton has requested that EPCOR perform the utility relocations within specific areas along the alignment prior to LRT construction.

The next stage of drainage work will include an outfall and storm line relocation in Blackmud Creek (Work Area #3). Work is scheduled to start in **late June 2023**.

## HOURS OF WORK

Regular working hours are **7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Monday to Saturday**. If required, these hours may be extended, and construction may occur on **Sundays from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.**

EPCOR will do everything possible to manage noise associated with the construction and will work to ensure that the construction is completed within the requirements of the City of Edmonton Noise Bylaw.

## SCHEDULE

There are four work areas of the drainage work:

**Work Area #1**– Storm relocation on the west side of 111 Street between 19 Avenue and 23 Avenue NW

- Currently underway and anticipated to be completed by **early August**

**Work Area #2**– Sanitary relocation on the west side of 111 Street, north of Blackmud Creek

- Expected to begin in **mid-July 2023** and anticipated to be completed by **early August 2023**

**Work Area #3** – Outfall & storm line relocation in Blackmud Creek

- Expected to begin in **late June 2023** and anticipated to be completed by **December 2023**
- Construction will involve work further outlined in this notice

**Work Area #4** – Sanitary relocation south of Blackmud Creek

- Expected to begin on in **early August 2023** and anticipated to be completed by **early September 2023**

*Timelines are estimates and may change based on weather and construction conditions.*

More information, including traffic impacts and timelines on remaining stages, will be shared with residents adjacent to the work areas prior to work starting.

## PEDESTRIAN IMPACTS

The sidewalk on the west side of 111 Street crossing Blackmud Creek will be closed. Pedestrians will be detoured onto the east side of 111 Street. Signage will be posted at each detour location on site to direct pedestrians.

## SAFETY

The construction areas will be fenced and/or marked as restricted areas. We will take every precaution to ensure public safety, and we request your assistance in keeping children and pets a safe distance from the construction site and the equipment. We thank you for your patience and understanding as we perform this necessary work.

## OTHER WORK IN THE AREA

### EPCOR Water

Water utility locations will occur along 111 Street both north and south of 23 Avenue. Work will include moving a water transmission main to the east side of 111 Street. Work is anticipated to be completed within **two months**.

### EPCOR Power

Power work is occurring along 111 Street from 19 Avenue NW to 25 Avenue NW to relocate electricity infrastructure. Work is anticipated to be completed by **early September 2023**, with additional power utility relocation work scheduled for fall.
