### WHAT'S IN A P-TRAP?

Let's talk about that curved pipe under your sink. Called a p-trap, this fixture is designed to create a water "trap" in your wastewater lines. When toilets or sinks aren't used often, p-traps can go dry and allow sulfurous sewer gasses into your home. Yuck.



Fortunately, most p-trap issues are easy to fix. Flush little-used toilets frequently to refill the p-trap. For a sink that smells less than sweet, pour half a gallon of water into the drain, with or without a cup of vinegar or bleach added, to clean out the p-trap and restore the water barrier.
