

With information about Arizona's drought making news, you may be wondering where the water in your tap comes from. Depending on where you live, your water could come from surface water sources, groundwater, or a mix of both types.

Surface water, generally, is considered to be a more sustainable type of water. This is water from rivers and streams that eventually flows into large-scale, managed systems. Groundwater, literally, is water from the ground. In Arizona, underground aquifers are used for storage of excess water as well as sources of groundwater.
