Will I still get my bill in the mail?

Reminder: Stage 2 Watering Restrictions in Effect

We are currently under Stage 2 outdoor watering restrictions. What this means:

- Odd-numbered addresses: Water on odd days only
- Even-numbered addresses: Water on even days only
- Max 2 hours per day, between 7-10 a.m. or 7-10 p.m.

Tip: Set your irrigation system to follow these rules automatically.

Use tree grow bags to water deeply and efficiently.

- Aerate your lawn in spring/fall to improve water absorption.
- Group plants with similar needs to avoid overwatering.
- Weed regularly to reduce competition for water.
- Aim sprinklers at plants—not sidewalks.
