WHAT'S IN A P-TRAP?

Let's talk about that curved pipe under your sink. Called a p-trap, this fixture creates a water "trap" in your wastewater lines. When toilets or sinks aren't used often, p-traps can go dry and allow sulfurous sewer gasses into your home. Yuck.

Flush little-used toilets frequently to refill the p-trap, and for a sink that smells less than sweet, pour half a gallon of water into the drain to restore the water barrier.
