CLEAN YOUR P-TRAP

Do you have an eggy, sulfurous smell coming from a rarely used toilet or sink? It could be coming from the curved pipe under your sink or in your bathroom. Called a p-trap, they create a water "trap" in your wastewater lines. When toilets or sinks aren't used often, p-traps can go dry and lead to the eggy, sulfurous smell. Yuck. Fortunately, most p-trap issues are easy to fix. Follow these steps:

- Flush little-used toilets more frequently
- For a sink that smells less than sweet, pour half a gallon of water into the drain, with or without a cup of vinegar or bleach added, to clean out the
