Along with the new rates, the Arizona Corporation Commission has approved the continuation of the Sustainable Water Surcharge for purchased water costs, a new Power Cost Adjustor Mechanism for changes to electrical costs, and an updated Rate Case Expense Surcharge for rate case costs.

The Commission also approved\* a Deferred Debit charge to begin recovery of costs authorized in the last rate case. Customers will see a monthly charge of \$3.02 on water bills and \$3.32 on wastewater bills.
