## NATURAL GAS SAFETY BASICS

Natural gas has a superior safety record, but small gas leaks can still occur. Just in time for National Safety Month, here's a quick refresher list of ways to detect leaks.

#### **SMELL IT**

In its pure state, natural gas has no smell. As a safety precaution, a scent called butyl mercaptan is added. This substance smells like rotten eggs or sulphur so that even the smallest leaks can be detected.

#### **SEE IT**

Natural gas is clear and colorless, but can leave visible signs of a leak including patches of dead vegetation, blowing dust from holes in the ground or bubbles in wet or flooded areas.

#### **HEAR IT**

A hissing or roaring noise along the location of an underground pipeline can indicate a natural gas leak.


