Bylaw 20865 EPCOR Wastewater Services Bylaw Code of Practice

Hauled Wastewater Discharge Requirements

This Code of Practice, adopted by EPCOR Water Services Inc. (EWSI), contains written requirements, standards, specifications, procedures, protocols or guidelines that form part of the Wastewater Collection Services Guidelines. Pursuant to the Terms and Conditions of Wastewater Collection and Wastewater Treatment Services ("Terms and Conditions") attached as Schedule 2 to Bylaw 20865: EPCOR Wastewater Services Bylaw approved by the City of Edmonton, as EPCOR Water Services Inc.'s regulator, the Terms and Conditions and the Wastewater Collection Services Guidelines are binding on all Customers.

1.0 **Application**

1.1 No Person shall release, discharge or permit the release of hauled wastewater to the sewerage system unless the discharge is done in accordance with this Code of Practice.

- 1.2 Nothing in this code of practice exempts a person from the requirements, penalties and/or liabilities within all applicable municipal, provincial, or federal legislation or standards.
- 1.3 Notwithstanding any terms, conditions or requirements of this Code of Practice, the release shall comply with all terms and provisions of Bylaw 20865.
- 1.4 Nothing in the Code of Practice in any way reduces the existing authority of the owner of the collection system or a municipal, provincial or federal legislator from prohibiting or placing additional conditions on the discharge.

2.0 **Discharge Requirements**

2.1 No Person shall release, discharge or permit the release of Hauled Wastewater unless the discharge is made at a location and in a manner approved by EWSI.

- 2.2 If the Approved Discharge Location uses an automated entry system, access cards must be used to enter and exit the facility.
- 2.3 All access cards must be issued to a specific vehicle.
- 2.4 Hauled wastewater must be accompanied by a manifest that includes all of the following information:
 - a) the generator(s) of the hauled wastewater;
 - b) date and time of loading;
 - c) the quantity and composition of hauled wastewater;
 - d) the name and contact information of the carrier;
 - e) the date, time, and location of release of the hauled wastewater; and
 - f) the name and contact information of the person consigning, hauling, and authorizing the release of the load.
- 2.5 The manifest for each load of hauled wastewater must be deposited in the drop box at the Approved Discharge Location.
- 2.6 A separate manifest must be completed for each load of hauled wastewater.
- 2.7 Hauled wastewater may not be diluted to meet Bylaw 20865 requirements.
- 2.8 All hauled wastewater is subject to inspection, sampling and analysis.
- 2.9 If any of the following occurs, the reporting procedures posted at the Approved Discharge Location must be followed:
 - a) the hauled wastewater overflows the containment pad; or
 - b) the vacuum pump releases to the ground.

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- 2.10 If a discharge portal at an Approved Discharge Location is barricaded, the next available discharge portal must be used.
- 2.11 Littering is not permitted at an Approved Discharge Location and may result in a suspension of access to an approved facility for a period of time.
- 2.12 When the release or discharge of Hauled Wastewater has been prohibited by EWSI in accordance with these Terms and Conditions, the Person prohibited from releasing or discharging the Hauled Wastewater must provide to EWSI the following information, in writing, within seven days of the prohibition:
 - a) the name and relevant contact information of the generator of the Wastewater that was prohibited;
 - b) the address from which the Wastewater that was prohibited originated;
 - c) a description of the location and equipment from which the Wastewater that was prohibited was collected;
 - d) the composition of the Wastewater that was prohibited; and
 - e) the final location at which the Wastewater was released.
