Follow these simple steps to eliminate FOGS from building up in your pipes:




Dispose of food scraps into the garbage before washing.




Wipe FOGS from pots and pans with a paper towel or spatula and throw into the garbage.



Collect used fryer grease and put directly into your outdoor used grease bin for recycling.



Use strainers to slow the buildup of solids in your grease trap and prevent blockages.



Clean your grease interceptors at least once a month.
