Garneau Emergency Power Cable Repair

OCTOBER 2023

In August, EPCOR sent you information about urgent power cable repair work happening in the Garneau neighbourhood. We are writing to provide you with an update on this project.

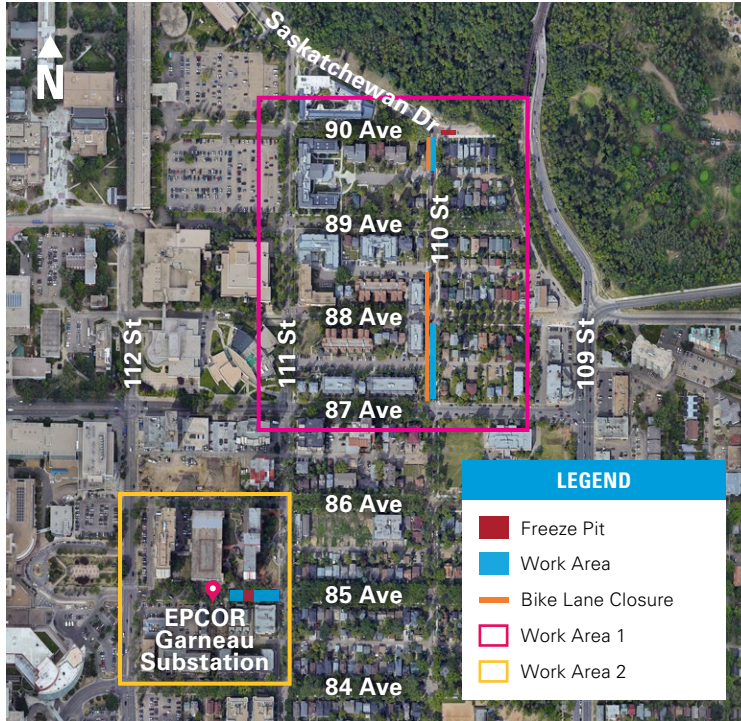
EPCOR performed initial damage assessments prior to work starting. However, once crews dug and located the cable underground, we learned that it sustained greater damage than first anticipated. To complete these complex repairs and ensure safe, reliable electricity, EPCOR will remain in the area until the **end of November**.

We'll continue working with the community to limit impacts as we complete this important repair. Your ongoing patience is appreciated.

WORK ACTIVITY TIMELINE

- Constructing two “freeze pits” one in front of the Garneau Substation located at 11123 85 Avenue and one at 110 Street and 90 Avenue – **Complete**
- Removing the section of damaged cables and replacing it with a new cable – **In Progress**
- Digging a new access pit in the work area along 110 Street at 88 Avenue to accommodate repairs to the cable pipe in that location – **October**
- Deconstructing the “freeze pits” at each work location – **Late October/November**
- Restoring the roadway and work areas – **November and early spring**

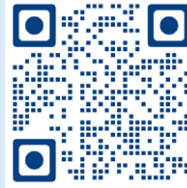
WORK AREA
