CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

86 and 88 Street between 40 and 41 Avenue NW

June 30, 2017



PROJECT OVERVIEW

The City of Edmonton will be upgrading the underground stormwater sewer system located within your neighbourhood (86 and 88 Street between 40 and 41 Avenue NW). This work is part of an overall flood mitigation project to reduce flood risk for the surrounding neighbourhoods.

CONSTRUCTION

The contract has been awarded to Weinrich Contracting Ltd. who will do the construction work along with Rulam Contracting Ltd. and Blacktop Paving Inc. within your neighbourhood. The construction will include excavation, piping installation, and restoration of the asphalt/concrete. Heavy equipment and trucks will be used for delivery of construction materials and for the work during the construction process. This may cause some minor vibrations and noise near your home.

Sewer & Water Servicing: We do not anticipate any interruption to water or sewer servicing during this work, but notices will be sent in advance of any scheduled interruptions.

SCHEDULE

Construction will begin mid-July of 2017. The project is expected to take two months and will be completed by the middle of September, weather permitting.

Typical hours of operation will be 7:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m. from Monday to Saturday, and 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Sundays.

SAFETY

The construction area will be fenced. Please keep children and pets a safe distance from the construction site and the equipment. If you see any acts of vandalism, trespassing, theft or tampering of equipment, signage or barricades please contact the Police at 780-423-4567.

TRAFFIC ACCOMMODATIONS

The Contractor will do their best to minimize traffic disruptions while ensuring local access for residents is maintained – note that street parking will be unavailable during certain periods.

In order to facilitate access, the contractor will utilize one lane closure on each street as well as the temporary shutdown of alley entrances. During active construction work, flag people will be on-site to assist with both vehicular and pedestrian traffic. In the event the site is shutdown, appropriate signage and barricading will be established to guide you past the working zone. Please pay special attention to the construction signage, staff, and equipment working in these areas, and reduce your speed to ensure the safety of our crews.
