CONSTRUCTION NOTICE Tweddle Place Dry Pond Expansion

June 30, 2017



PROJECT OVERVIEW

The City of Edmonton will be constructing a dry pond, located within the Tweddle Place neighbourhood parallel to 91 Street. This work is part of an overall flood mitigation project to reduce flood risk for the surrounding neighbourhoods. The dry pond will provide additional capacity in order to accommodate excess storm water generated by severe rainfalls. It will also help to reduce the surface ponding and alleviate the risk of sewers backing up into basements.

CONSTRUCTION

Weinrich Contracting Ltd. has been awarded the dry pond construction work. The construction will include excavation, drain inlet and outlet structures, tree removal, pathway installation, landscaping, and the installation of a vegetated sound barrier. Heavy equipment and trucks will be used for delivery of construction materials as well as dirt removal during the construction process. This may cause some minor vibrations and noise near the pond area. Typical hours of operation will be 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Monday to Saturday, and 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Sundays.

Sewer & Water Servicing: We do not anticipate any interruption to water or sewer servicing during this work, but notices will be sent in advance of any scheduled interruptions.

SCHEDULE

Construction will begin early July of 2017. The project is expected to take 17 months and will be completed by the end of November 2018, weather permitting.

SAFETY

The construction area will be fenced. Please keep children and pets a safe distance from the construction site and the equipment. If you see any acts of vandalism, trespassing, theft or tampering of equipment, signage or barricades please contact the Police at 780-423-4567.

TRAFFIC ACCOMMODATIONS

No full road closures are expected during this construction. The Contractor will be accessing the site from 91 Street for their scope of work and will utilize best efforts to minimize traffic disruptions within the neighbourhood. Note that street parking will be unavailable for brief periods in order to facilitate pathway and crosswalk construction.
