



RIVER VALLEY ROAD UNDERGROUND POWER REPAIR

January 2015

What is happening?

We need to repair an underground power cable located along River Valley Road, directly south of the Victoria Park parking lot (see map on back page). The cable is showing signs of aging and needs to be repaired.

When will construction begin?

We anticipate work to start mid-February 2015. However, depending on weather and project approvals, we may not start until later in the spring. Once construction has started we anticipate it taking approximately eight weeks.

What can I expect during construction?

VISUAL

You can expect to see activity that is typical to construction, such as:

- Construction barricades, fences, and signs.
- Company/ contractor vehicles and equipment around the work sites.
- Three construction site tents.
- Small power generators and associated equipment.

CONSTRUCTION NOISE

The proposed work will create noise typically associated with construction. We will take measures to ensure we comply with the City of Edmonton's Community Standards Bylaw for Noise Control. If it is necessary to temporarily exceed acceptable noise levels, we will work with the City of Edmonton to obtain the required permits.

HOURS OF OPERATION

In order to minimize the length of construction, we plan on working 24 hours a day, 7 days a week for approximately eight weeks.

POWER SUPPLY

We do not anticipate any planned interruptions to your power service resulting from this work.

WORK SPACE AND ENVIRONMENT

All work areas will be maintained in a safe and secure manner. All construction activities will be performed in accordance with the City of Edmonton bylaws, Occupational Health and Safety requirements as well as EPCOR's health, safety and environmental procedures and guidelines.

ROAD AND SIDEWALK CLOSURES

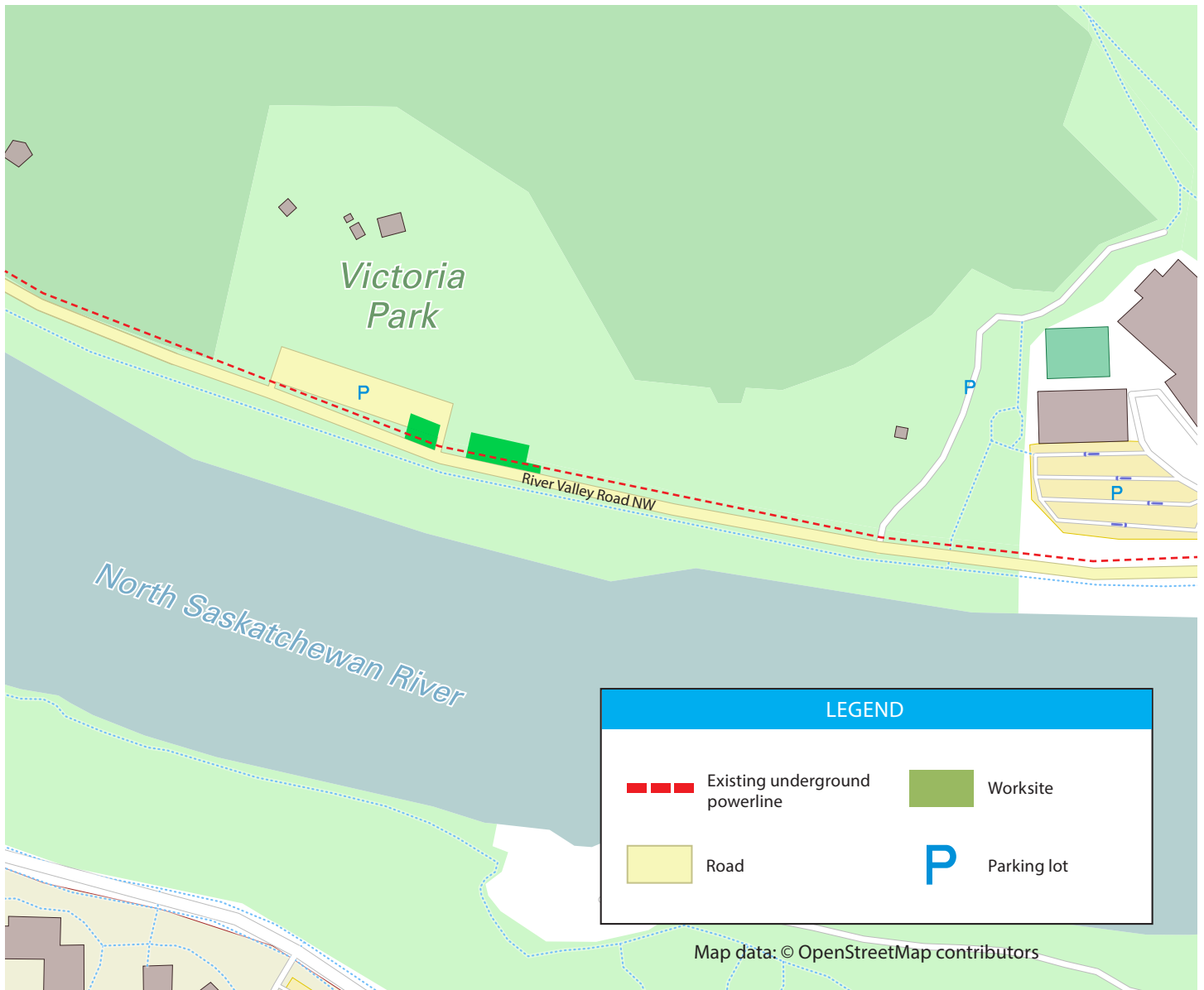
Sidewalks:

- The sidewalk south of River Valley Road will remain open during construction.

Roads:

- River Valley Road will remain open during construction, but westbound traffic may be temporarily interrupted to allow equipment access to the worksite. Signs will be posted in affected areas.
- The area shown in green on the map will be closed during construction. The majority of the work will take place on the City boulevard; however, the east entrance/ exit to the Victoria Park parking lot may be temporarily closed to allow equipment access to the worksite.
