EPCOR Rossdale Water Treatment Plant Water Dechlorination Project

Construction Start: *July 2010*
Proposed Completion: *Summer 2011*

WHAT'S HAPPENING?

There will be construction of a few small structures and upgrading of existing facilities on the east and south side of the Rossdale water treatment plant site.

HOW WILL I BE AFFECTED BY THE CONSTRUCTION?

EPCOR will strive to complete the work while minimizing overall impact to the community.

- There will be typical noise associated with construction.
- Typical work hours are expected to be between 7:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. with occasional work beyond these hours.
- All construction activity will adhere to the City of Edmonton noise bylaw (Monday through Saturday – 7am – 10pm and Sunday and Statutory Holidays – 9am – 7pm).

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THIS PROJECT?

EPCOR is proceeding with an environmental upgrade to the water plant operation in order to meet provincial regulations. The upgrade will allow the removal of chlorine from any residuals resulting from the treatment process.

ARE THERE ANY SAFETY ISSUES?

When construction on the east side of the plant occurs, the fence will be relocated and existing landscaping on the EPCOR site will be removed to allow for excavation. Landscaping and fencing will be restored upon completion. Please contact the EPCOR Project Manager if you have any concerns.

ADDITION PROJECT-SPECIFIC ITEMS, IF NECESSARY

The upgrades are consistent with the plans described in the recent EPCOR bulletin distributed in January 2010 to Rossdale residents and presented at an Open House in February 2010. The bulletin can be viewed online at epcor.ca.
