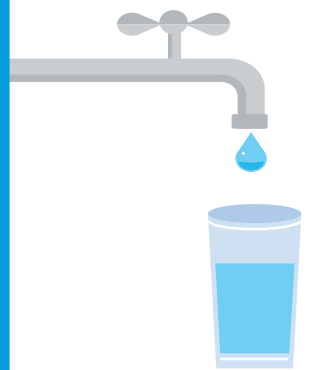

## YOUR RATES ARE CHANGING



**RATES FOR SERVICE IN EPCOR'S TUBAC WATER DISTRICT ARE REVIEWED AND APPROVED BY THE ARIZONA CORPORATION COMMISSION (ACC). EPCOR FILED AN APPLICATION REQUESTING AN INCREASE TO ITS RATES AND CHARGES ON MARCH 10, 2014. ON AUGUST 27, 2015, THE ACC VOTED TO APPROVE NEW RATES AND TARIFFS FOR THE TUBAC WATER DISTRICT IN DECISION NO. 75268. NEW RATES ARE EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 1, 2015.**



### **EXAMPLE:**

In Phase 1, the monthly water bill for an average Tubac residential customer with a 5/8 x 3/4-inch meter using 8,348 gallons per month will increase from \$46.44 to \$63.97, an increase of \$17.53 or approximately 37.74 percent. In Phases 2 and 3, the same customer will see an additional increase of \$8.03 per month in the second year and \$8.15 per month in the third year.

Customers will also see a decrease in the monthly surcharge for arsenic treatment costs. The average customer will see a decrease of \$3.44.

You may see an adjustment on your bill to reflect these changes. For example, if your bill is for service from August 15 to September 15, you'll be charged under the old rates from August 15 through August 31 and under the new rates from September 1 through September 15.
