In addition to the collection of regular rates, the utility will collect from its customers a proportionate share of any privilege, sales, use and franchise tax, per A.A.C. R14-2-409(D)(5).

In Decision #74568, the ACC approved a revised low-income assistance program for the Chaparral City Water Company district. Up to 250 customers who meet the program's eligibility requirements may be eligible for a monthly credit of \$7.50 on their bill. All utilities in Arizona are assessed an annual fee by the ACC and the Residential Utility Consumer Office. This fee contributes to the cost of regulating public utilities and was previously included in the base rates for Chaparral City Water Company. In Decision #74568, the ACC approved EPCOR to list this monthly fee as a separate line item on Chaparral City Water Company bills. Beginning July 1, 2014, you'll see the ACC Regulatory Assessment Fee appear as a separate line item on your monthly bill – the amount of the assessment is adjusted each August.
