Purpose:

The January 2024 "Addendum to City of Edmonton Design and Construction Standards Volume 4: Section 1" provides an update to fire protection requirements to align with the City of Edmonton Zoning Bylaw Renewal. The update is based on analysis performed by Edmonton Fire Rescue and supported by a development industry stakeholder committee.
